**Financial Impact** 

Savings

- NECC Program eliminated the tuition need for out of district placements
- Used existing teachers and related service providers for services
- NECC has built in training for staff each day
- □ In district transportation less than out of district transportation





**Financial Impact** 

**Increased Costs** 

- □ Increase in support staff hours
- Cost of NECC Partner Program
- Struggle to find support staff has resulted in contracted staff providing the support services





Child Find Coordinator

- □ Communicates with area agencies and early childhood providers
- Works collaboratively with each school in the district
- □ Acts as the LEA for meetings
- Completes evaluations and paperwork to provide consistency across the district allowing teachers more time to provide instruction and services in classes





Child Find Coordinator

- Number of ESS referrals processed: 15 (1 not identified)
  - Number of Parent referrals: 22 (6 not identified, preschool/pre kindergarten)
- Number of children attended Child Find: 6 (4 evaluated, 2 not evaluated)
- Number of meetings attended: 86 preschool -prekindergarten
- Number of evaluations completed: 28

- □ Students stay in their district with peers
